### "National Day of the Cowboy"

The National Day of the Cowboy Celebration in Uptown Sedona is a free community event on Saturday, July 24th, 2010 from 10:00 am to 8:00 pm along "Main Street" (State Route 89A) and Jordan Road. Come enjoy "a whole lot of cowboy goin's on" in the midst of red rock country. It all begins with a Cowboy Parade down Jordan Road. Gunfights begin at High Noon as part of live performances non-stop at Cowboy Plaza. There will be gunslingin', whip crackin' and trick ropin' along with the live performances of gunfights and historical reenactments. All along the sidewalks and plazas you can enjoy these activities and more - listen to cowboy storytelling, try your hand at roping and get a lesson or two to boot, quench your thirst and satisfy your hunger, hear live country western music, view the work of cowboy artists and watch blacksmithing and saddle making, then step up for some cowboy karaoke. Come as you are or put on your western duds and celebrate our history. Along Main Street sidewalks and plazas you'll find live western music, cowboy artists and western trades and crafts demonstrations. You can even try your hand at riding a mechanical bull. Wear your western finery and compete for prizes in the Spirit of the West Outfit Contest.

Jewelry artist Cheston Trammel will be the featured artist in residence at Goldenstein Gallery for the National Day of the Cowboy. A fifth generation Verde Valley native, he has developed a unique style of stone carving and leather braided jewelry that is great looking and incredibly comfortable to wear. This self-taught artist, has developed a beautiful technique of jewelry making, using local stones. He started carving as a child, whittling wood with his grandfather. As a young adult he began carving small stone fetishes. Cheston has always been fascinated by the Native American culture. You will notice this expressed in his Taos Men series. These wearable stone tablets show pueblo ruins as well as spiritual symbols used for centuries. Stop by the gallery and meet Cheston during this fun-filled celebration.
